

Our volunteer organizers have been planning for this special day for quite some time. Membership Recruitment

While our big membership drive traditionally occurs at the end of each year, we continue to welcome new members into the Park Shore Association as new families and individuals move into our neighborhood.

An annual household membership is just \$125. Seventy-five percent of this fee covers operating expenses, such as maintaining the Raymond Lutgert Park at Park Shore. The rest goes toward a capital fund to help pay for future improvements and reserves to cover any losses in a storm like Hurricane Irma. For new members, there is a one-time initiation fee of \$200 to cover the costs of processing applications.
